Dear Mr. De Cotiis:

In preparation for the upcoming meeting and the discussion of window washing proposals, the Building and Landscape Committee observed a variety of construction related problems including paint overspray, caulking/sealant droppings, chipped or damaged metal moldings, as well as a thick layer of construction dust and soot on the aluminum window frames. It was the understanding of the homeowner Board members and committee that a complete construction cleaning was done. However, it appears that only the windows were cleaned and not the frames.

The homeowner Board members request that a complete post-construction cleaning of the window frames be performed. This cleaning would also provide Pinnacle International with an excellent opportunity to perform a test of the window washing equipment to determine if the equipment is functioning according to design prior to the first window cleaning.
