"Primal Twang: The Legend of the Guitar"

Doc Watson, Albert Lee and Eric Johnson are among the internationally prominent performers joining forces here for the world premiere of "Primal Twang: The Legacy of the Guitar." To be held September 7-10 at the Stephen and Mary Birch North Park Theatre, the four shows will combine live performances with a multimedia theatrical presentation that traces the guitar's 3,500-year history. The brainchild of flat-picking guitar star Dan Crary, "Primal Twang" also will feature Mason Williams, the Los Angeles Guitar Quartet's Andrew York, Grand Ole Opry star Doyle Dykes and San Diego jazz mainstay Peter Sprague. They'll be joined by John Doan and Beppe Gambetta, who both play 20-stringed harp guitars, and a backing band that includes Crary, multi-instrumental wiz Dennis Caplinger, drummer Duncan Moore and local guitarists Fred Benedetti and George Svoboda. Computer Recycling with Reconnect San Diego

Goodwill Industries of San Diego County and Dell have introduced Reconnect San Diego, a free drop-off program for recycling of unwanted computers. The pilot program will help protect the environment through the responsible recycling of computer equipment, and provide area residents a convenient opportunity to support a local nonprofit organization. San Diego residents can call toll-free (888) -4-GOODWILL or visit reconnectpartnership.com or sdgoodwill.org to locate the most convenient drop-off location at any of the 24 local Goodwill donation centers and retail stores. Goodwill will sort the donated computer equipment, which will be recycled through the Dell Asset Recovery Services value recovery program. Dell's product recovery partner will remarket the recycled materials, such as plastics, glass and metals, and all sales proceeds will go to Goodwill to support the nonprofit's job training and employment services programs.

San Diego Thunder Boat Regatta 2006
