The San Diego Boat Show

The 2007 San Diego Boat Show is a standout in its 19th year because of the growth in size but also because of some of the new features. The "Take Me Fishing Tour" will be in the expanded area of the show. Sponsored by the Recreation Boating and Fishing Foundation, the interactive exhibit is making less than 10 stops at boat shows across the country – and San Diego is one of them. The "Take Me Fishing Tour" includes fishing simulators, a casting pond, information stations, entertainment and fishing seminars. As seen on national TV, "Splash Dogs" showcases dogs that broad jump from a dock into a pool. The "Splash Dogs" will be featured in the Big Bay Kids Area portion of our show. Other feature of the Kids area include; puppet shows, boat painting, balloons, and many interactive activities. Located near the show's entrance, talk with The Boating Guy, do research on-line, and get impartial information about all aspect of boating. Find out how to get into boating and learn what kind of boat might be right for you. Visit the boats in-water at the Marriott docks and while you're there take a sailboat ride with Discover Sailing! The San Diego Boat Show takes place January 4-7 and the San Diego Convention Center as well as the Marriott Marina.

Carlsbad San Diego Marathon 2007

Witness one of the oldest marathon traditions on the West Coast as the newly renamed Carlsbad San Diego Marathon and Half Marathon races through Carlsbad again this January. From the ideal weather conditions to the spectacular coastal course, the award winning event will wow you! The 26 fully staffed support stations, continuous entertainment, and unsurpassed volunteer support are just a few of the outstanding features. This boutique style with an emphasis on quality and individual service sets them apart from the mega marathons. On January 20, the day before the full and half-marathon contests, there will be a Kids' Marathon Mile. All events start at Plaza Camino Real in Carlsbad. Those waiting for participants to finish can visit the Health and Fitness Expo under the Big Top at Plaza Camino Real. There will be vendors, interactive displays and guest speakers. The race begins at 7:30 am on Sunday, January 21. Check with your Concierge about entry fee.

Buick Invitational 2007

The Torrey Pines Golf Course again hosts the PGA Tour's Buick Invitational, an event that's been won a record four times by defending champion Tiger Woods. Always action-packed, the tourney culminated last year in a suspenseful face-off between Woods and two-time Masters champ Jose Maria Olazabal on the 16th hole. The Buick has a full week of events, including practice rounds and Pro-Ams, plus a Helicopter Ball Drop on Saturday, January 27.Tiger Woods won the 2005 and 2006 titles at Torrey Pines. Can he do it again in 2007? The annual Buick Invitational is scheduled for January 22-28, featuring a full field of players and a \$5 million purse. Single weekday tickets (good for one day) are \$19. Saturday and Sunday tickets will cost \$24 each (they also offer a senior discount). Or go for the Season Badge for \$90 which is good all week long. See your Concierge for more information.
