At the charming new Sole Luna Café, the food is inexpensive and the Italian lessons are free. The two young proprietors, Gigio Piazza and Alessandro Speroni, brought along café and culinary traditions from their respective hometowns of Milan and Bologna. Besides frothy cups of Cappuccino, Sole Luna offers *panini* built like those in Milan. The *rustico* includes prosciutto-like *speck*, along with goat cheese and olive pâté, and the *genovese* encloses cooked ham, fresh mozzarella, sliced tomato, and pesto. Lasagna, meat-filled
