San Diego Italian Film Festival

MoPA with the Istituo Italiano di Cultura of Los Angeles presents the San Diego Italian Film Festival. There will be 20 free films shown at MoPa. Films will be shown in Italian with English subtitles. These films are known here as "Spaghetti Westerns" but in Italy as "Westerns all 'Italiana". Enjoy "For A Few Dollars More" at 7 pm July 3, and "The Good, the Bad and the Ugly" at 7 pm on August 7. Both are directed by Sergio Leone and star Clint Eastwood, with music by Ennio Morricone. It has always been part of the original MoPA design to incorporate all of the photographic arts. In March of 2000, with the help of a generous donation from Joan and Irwin Jacobs, Director Arthur Ollman's goal of providing a film program became a reality. The Joan & Irwin Jacobs Theater is an intimate, comfortable space for one to tap into the history of cinema.
